During candidacy, your school will work towards the fulfillment of the requirements for authorization as identified in the relevant Guide to school authorization.

Please note that your school may not advertise itself as an IB World School authorized to offer the MYP until it has received an official IB notification of authorization. You are, however, entitled to describe your school as a candidate school. If you wish to advertise this information, you are required to use the following text:

St. Joseph's Junior and Senior High School is a candidate school* for the MYP. This school is pursuing authorization as an IB World School. IB World Schools share a common philosophy- a commitment to high-quality, challenging, international education- that we believe is important for our students.
